Analysis Summary

House Bill 4127 would amend the Insurance Code by prohibiting auto insurers from influencing the insured's decision as to who will do the auto repair and what specific brand of materials will be used for the repair. The bill also requires timely and full payment of the insured's selected repair

shop and materials.

Fiscal Impact

There would be no fiscal impact on local units of government by this bill. The fiscal impact on State government would be difficult to determine tending towards negligible. Department of Consumer & Industry Services staff indicated that the bill would probably prompt the department to develop

and produce a publication to make consumers aware of the law.
