Analysis Summary

This bill would prohibit the construction of boat hoists or docks at public access sites unless the riparian owner authorizes the improvement. Persons would be prohibited from picnicking, lounging or sunbathing, and vessel operators would be prohibited from mooring overnight offshore from an access site. A violation of these provisions would be a misdemeanor offense.

**Fiscal Impact** 

There would be no fiscal impact on the state. There would be an indeterminate local impact. Revenue realized through fines would be

provided to local libraries.
