REVISE ABANDONED VEHICLE PROCEDURES



Bill/Sponsor **HOUSE BILL 4231 as introduced, Rep. James Koetje**

Analysis **Summary**
House Bill 4231 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to make a number of revisions to the procedures for stickering, removing, and selling abandoned vehicles.

Fiscal Impact
The bill would potentially decrease state and local costs by removing a provision requiring a police agency reimburse an owner for towing and storage fees if a court finds that a vehicle was not properly considered abandoned. Local judicial costs could increase due to new provisions requiring court officers to carry out certain procedures related to the sale of abandoned vehicles.

The magnitudes of these possible impacts are indeterminate, but likely to be relatively small.
