Analysis Summary

House Bill 4283 would amend the Michigan Telecommunications Act mandating that a provider of a regulated service shall not discontinue regulated service to the residence of a customer who is a member of the national guard or military reservist on active duty. It is also requires the Public Service Commission to establish notification procedures for the customer and service provider, and determines what conditions that service can be discontinued.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact to the State is indeterminate. House Bill 4283 if enacted may require the Department of Consumer and Industry Services to implement or revise procedures within the Public Service Commission. The estimate is that the costs would be small and indeterminate.
