## Fiscal Analysis WIRELESS EMERGENCY PHONE SERVICE CONNECTION FEE

**Analysis** Summary

The current act provides the assessment of an emergency 9-1-1 service charge of 52 cents per month for each commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) connection. The assessment of the fee is set to be expired on January 1, 2004. The bill would extend the repeal effective as of July 1, 2004. In addition, the bill would repeal the entire act effective June 30, 2007.

**Fiscal Impact** 

A total of \$17 million has been collected in FY 2002-03 from the assessment of an emergency 9-1-1 service charge. The assessment for another 6 months would allow collection of additional revenue in the amount of approximately \$8.5 million. However, the collection amount would vary year to year

depending on the frequency of usage.
