DIPLOMAS FOR KOREAN WAR VETERANS

Analysis **Summary**

The bill would amend Public Act 181 of 2001 to allow school district boards to award high school diplomas to Korean War veterans under certain circumstances. Currently, only World War II veterans may be awarded diplomas under the provisions of the act.

Fiscal Impact

The bill would not have a substantial fiscal impact, although administrative costs for local school districts and the state Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (in responding to inquiries about the program) could increase.
