Analysis

Summary

House Bill 4652 (H-1) amends Part 26 of the Public Health Code, regarding Data, Information, and Research. The bill amends the statute regarding the prohibition of the sale, transfer, distribution or gift of an embryo, fetus or neonate for a use that violates Sections 2685 to 2689. The bill adds that a person shall not collect a fee for an embryo, fetus or neonate. The bill adds that a person shall not financially benefit from any distribution of any portion of an embryo, fetus or neonate, including any obtained from an elective abortion. "Elective abortion" is defined as it is currently defined in Public Act 360 of 2002.
