Analysis

Summary

This bill would amend PA 205, The Paternity Act of 1956, to require the court to apportion the expenses of the mother's confinement and pregnancy between the parents when a child is born out of wedlock. The parent who did not pay the expense would be ordered to pay his or her share to the other parent.

Fiscal Impact

This bill will raise court administrative costs by a moderate, but indeterminate, amount. This bill will have no fiscal impact on the Family Independence Agency
