## Fiscal Analysis Local agency fingerprinting fee

Analysis Summary

House Bill 4818 would amend Public Act 372 of 1927 to require that a \$15.00 fee to be paid by a concealed weapon license applicant to a local police agency that takes fingerprints from the applicant. Under the current statute, an applicant may request that fingerprints be taken by either the county sheriff or a local police agency. This \$15.00 fee would be in addition to the existing \$105.00 fee for concealed weapon license applications.

**Fiscal Impact** 

No information is available on the number of local agencies that maintain fingerprinting capabilities or the number of applicants that would opt to have fingerprints taken by a local agency, rather than the county sheriff, so the increase in revenue for local agencies under the bill is indeterminate.
