Summary

House Bill 5188 would amend Public Act 3 of 1939 requiring the Michigan Public Service Commission to extend the temporary waiver for Consumers Energy's Appliance Service Plan (ASP) through July 1, 2004. The ASP is a voluntary repair program for large home appliances, for which Consumers Energy charges its customers a monthly fee on their utility bill.

Fiscal Impact

There would be no fiscal impact to either the State or local units of government by this bill.
