House Committee**Analysis****Summary**

This bill would require a county to secure voter approval before a waste reduction surcharge could be imposed. Any such surcharge on households and commercial businesses could be collected through the local property tax, water and sewage use, or other household/commercial services provided by a county government.

Fiscal Impact

This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the state or on local government, provided the voter referendum permitted by this bill occurs at a regularly scheduled general election.
