This bill would allow individuals to donate \$1.00 to the Sportsmen Against Hunger Program when purchasing hunting or fishing licenses. A sportsmen against hunger fund would be created in the state treasury. Revenues would be collected by the Department of Natural Resources and deposited into this

new fund. Monthly disbursements would be made to the non-profit

organization, Sportsmen Against Hunger.
