Analysis

Summary

House Bill (HB) 5334 would exempt shooting ranges that permit law enforcement officers to train free of charge from the property tax.

Fiscal Impact

This bill would reduce property tax revenue by less than an estimated \$1 million. Of the total fiscal impact, approximately 12% of the reduction would come from the State education tax, all of which is earmarked to the School Aid Fund (SAF). In addition, SAF expenditures would increase to replace the estimated revenue reduction for the school districts. Approximately 53% of the property tax reduction would be incurred by local units of government.
