Analysis

Summary

House Bill 5391 would amend Public Act 44 of 1899, which governs the publication and distribution of state laws and other documents. HB 5391 would reduce the number of copies of Public and Local Acts distributed from 42 to the Secretary of the Senate and 120 to the Clerk of the House of Representatives to 10 copies to each. Also, the bill would delete the requirement that each member of the Legislature receive a complete set of the Public and Local Acts.

In regard to the Michigan Manual, the bill specifies that one copy of the Michigan Manual would be provided to each member of the Legislature unless a member waives his or her right to receive a copy.

Fiscal Impact

HB 5391 would result in a minimal amount of savings to the state, the exact amount being indeterminate. Any savings resulting from the bill would help to offset reductions taken in the FY 2004 budget.
