A SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 1243 AS PASSED BY THE SENATE

Senate Bill 1243 would amend Public Act 142 of 2001, the Michigan Memorial Highway Act (MCL 250.1001 et seq.), by adding Section 73 to designate that part of highway I-69 in Branch County as the "Purple Heart Trail".

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2 of Public Act 142 indicates that the state transportation department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway "when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers." As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
