ADDENDUM TO SENATE FISCAL AGENCY ANALYSIS OF SB 180 (H-1) DATED 3-4-03:

HOUSE COMMITTEE ACTION:

The bill would prohibit a state agency from using a 900 telephone number or other telephone system that charged a caller for access to public information held or maintained by a state agency. The House Committee on Government Operations adopted a substitute that added an effective date of January 1, 2004.
