A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4875 AS INTRODUCED 6-24-03

The bill would amend the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to permit a senior citizen to take deer with a crossbow during the bow and arrow deer season, provided that he or she has a bow and arrow deer hunting license. (The term "senior citizen" refers to a resident 65 years of age or older.)
