A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5172 AS INTRODUCED 10-15-03

Public Act 550 of 2002 (Senate Bill 534) amended the Cemetery Regulation Act to allow a court-appointed receiver or conservator to sell, assign, transfer, or convey a cemetery to a municipal corporation or other person (except to a funeral home owner, operator, or supervisor, or a person licensed in mortuary science). <u>House Bill 5172</u> would specify that this provision would apply to a cemetery in receivership on the July 26, 2002 effective date of Public Act 550.
