

PROHIBIT E-FILE REQUIREMENT FOR TAX PREPARERS

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5434 AND 5440 AS INTRODUCED 1-27-04

Both bills would prohibit the Department of Treasury from requiring any person who prepares a tax return on behalf on another person for compensation to file electronically. <u>House Bill 5434</u> would amend the Income Tax Act (MCL 206.471), and <u>House Bill 5440</u> would amend the Single Business Tax Act (208.80). Further, House Bill 5434 would specify that, for purposes of the income tax, the taxpayer would determine whether his or her tax return was filed electronically.
