House Changes to Senate-Passed:		
1.	Hazardous Materials Programs. The House increased Federal authorization to reflect recent and expected first responder grants from U.S. Department of Justice.	48,600,000
2.	At-Post Troopers. The House provided a higher amount in new restricted revenue from fees to support Trooper salaries/school, reflecting Governor's recommendation of \$36.4 million.	2,500,000
3.	Special Operations. The House added private funds authorization to allow for receipt of donations to canine unit.	10,000
4.	Traffic Safety. The House made a technical change to show actual IDG funds received.	2,300
5.	Items-of-Difference. The House decreased line items by \$100 each to create items-of-difference.	(2,900)

Changes from FY 2003-04 Senate-Passed:

- 1. At-Post Trooper Strength. The House amended this section to specify that a trooper school conducted during FY 2003-04 shall have the goal of maintaining a statewide trooper strength of at least 1,075 rather than a graduation of at least 110 new troopers as in the Senate version. The House also added language stating legislative intent to statutorily transfer \$5.0 million from the auto theft prevention fund to achieve the trooper strength goal. (Sec. 222)
- 2. **Highland Park Assistance.** The House deleted a section which required the department to assist the city of Highland Park with law enforcement services. (Sec. 263)
- 3. **Marshall State Police Post.** The House deleted a section which requires funding for rental costs for a State police post in Marshall. (Sec. 264)
- 4. **Emergency Management Funds.** The House amended the section by adding the requirement that if any additional expenditure in the Michigan administrative network is approved by the State Budget Office for this unit, the Legislature shall be notified within ten days on the amount and purpose of those expenditures. (Sec. 1001)
- Statewide Emergency Management Computer Network. The House added a section which requires the department to not make any purchase related to the system unless authorized by the Director of Information Technology. (Sec.802)
- 6. **Proceeds From Sale of Aircraft.** The House amended the section by adding the requirement that if any additional expenditure in the Michigan administrative network is approved by the State Budget Office for this unit, the Legislature shall be notified within ten days on the amount and purpose of those expenditures. (Sec. 1201)
- 7. **Canine Unit Donations.** The House added a section which allows the department to spend donated funds, and for those funds not to be used to supplant GF/GP appropriations for the unit. (Sec.1002)
- 8. **Motor Carrier Enforcement.** The House deleted a section which requires maximum use of funds for enforcement and an annual report of funding allocation plans. (Sec. 1202)
- 9. **Motor Carrier School Allocation.** The House deleted a section which requires, should homeland security funds become available, a motor carrier school to be held from which seven officers shall be added to the second district of southeast Michigan (Sec. 264)
