House Changes to Senate-Passed:	
 Court of Appeals. The House added State restricted funding to the Court of Appeals operations line in expectation of additional fee revenue from increased motion and copy fees. 	100,500
 Drug Court Programs. The House added additional Federal funding in expectation of a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice for drug court training and evaluation. 	300,000
 Points of Difference. The House created points of difference in multiple line items by decreasing each by \$100. 	(2,300)

Changes from FY 2002-03 Senate-Passed:

- 1. **Report Retention.** The House restored Section 212 which requires that the Judiciary follow Federal and State guidelines regarding the retention of reports.
- 2. **Judicial Technology Improvement Fund**. The House amended section 313(3) to say that "not less than \$1,000,000 and not more than \$2,000,000 shall be utilized" rather than "up to \$1,000,000 may be utilized" for the development and operation of a Cyber Court.
