House Bill 5664 (Substitute H-1 as reported without amendment)

### **CONTENT**

The bill would amend Part 184 of the Public Health Code (which governs sanitarians) to do the following:

- Adopt by reference the standards of the National Environmental Health Association as they exist on the bill's effective date relative to qualifications, education, and examinations.
- Require the Department of Community Health (DCH) to accept the certification by that Association of the successful completion of any education or examination for purposes of registration under Part 184.
- Create an advisory committee to make recommendations to the DCH concerning registration qualifications, training standards, and disciplinary actions.
- Eliminate language creating the Michigan Board of Sanitarians.
