THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) A retail dealer shall not transfer, sell,
- 2 dispense, or offer gasoline for sale in this state unless the
- 3 pump dispensing the gasoline is posted with a notice, as provided
- 4 in subsection (2), that indicates the grade of gasoline and the
- 5 additives in the gasoline that are dispensed from the pump. If
- 6 the gasoline contains at least 1% alcohol by volume, the notice
- 7 shall state: "Contains (indicate the type of alcohol such as
- 8 -ethanol or methanol, and if methanol the label shall state
- 9 "alcohol: methanol", followed, in the same size type, by the
- 10 concentration to the nearest whole percent)". However, if If
- 11 the gasoline contains alcohols or ethers that have a molecular

- 25 inspection and testing fund created by section 8.
