A bill to amend 1976 PA 267, entitled "Open meetings act,"

by amending section 9 (MCL 15.269), as amended by 1982 PA 130.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 9. (1) Each public body shall keep minutes of each
- 2 meeting showing the date, time, place, members present, members
- 3 absent, any decisions made at a meeting open to the public, and
- 4 the purpose or purposes for which a closed session is held. The
- 5 minutes shall include all roll call votes taken at the meeting.
- 6 -Corrections The public body shall make any corrections in the
- 7 minutes -shall be made not later than at the next meeting after
- 8 the meeting to which the minutes refer. Corrected The public
- 9 body shall make corrected minutes -shall be available -no later
- 10 than at or before the next subsequent meeting after correction.
- 11 The corrected minutes shall show both the original entry and the

- 2 (2) Minutes shall be are public records open to public
- 3 inspection, and a public body shall be make the minutes
- 4 available at the address designated on posted public notices
- 5 pursuant to section 4. Copies The public body shall make

- 7 reasonable estimated cost for printing and copying.
- 8 (3) Proposed A public body shall make proposed minutes
- 9 -shall be available for public inspection -not more than within
- 10 8 business days after the meeting to which the minutes refer.
- 11 Approved The public body shall make approved minutes shall be
- 12 available for public inspection -not later than within 5
- 13 business days after the meeting at which the minutes are approved
- 14 by the public body.
- 15 (4) A public body shall not include in or with its minutes
- 16 any personally identifiable information that, if released, would
- 17 prevent the public body from complying with section 444 of
- 18 subpart 4 of part C of the general education provisions act, 20
- 19 USC 1232g, commonly referred to as the family educational rights
- 20 and privacy act of 1974.
