## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5914

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40116 (MCL 324.40116), as amended by 1996 PA 154.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 40116. (1)  $\rightarrow$  Subject to subsection (3), a person
- 2 shall not take game during the established daylight shooting
- 3 hours from August 15 through April 30 unless the person wears a
- 4 cap, hat, vest, jacket, or rain gear of the highly visible color
- 5 commonly referred to as hunter orange. Hunter orange includes
- 6 blaze orange, flame orange, or fluorescent blaze orange, and
- 7 camouflage that is not less than 50% hunter orange. The garments
- 8 that are hunter orange or of a camouflage design that is at
- 9 least 50% hunter orange. The garment that is hunter orange or of
- 10 a camouflage design that is at least 50% hunter orange shall be

- 1 the hunter's outermost garment and shall be visible from all
- 2 sides of the hunter. This section does
- 3 (2) Subject to subsection (3), a person shall not make use
- 4 of a blind to take game on lands open to public hunting unless
- 5 hunter orange is visible on the exterior surface of the blind
- 6 from all sides.
- 7 (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to a person who is making
- 8 use of a blind to take game. Subsections (1) and (2) do not
- 9 apply to a person engaged in the taking of deer with a bow during
- 10 archery deer season, a person taking bear with a bow, or a person
- 11 engaged in the taking of waterfowl, crow, or turkey.
- 12 (4) -(2) The failure of a person to comply with this section
- 13 is not evidence of contributory negligence in a civil action for
- 14 injury to the person or for the person's wrongful death.
- 15 (5) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Blind" means an enclosure used to help conceal or
- 17 disguise the occupant for the purpose of taking game. Blind does
- 18 not include an enclosure built of dead natural materials found in
- 19 nature.
- 20 (b) "Hunter orange" means the highly visible color commonly
- 21 referred to as hunter orange and includes blaze orange, flame
- 22 orange, and fluorescent blaze orange.
