

# SENATE BILL No. 1260

(As amended, June 15, 2004)

May 25, 2004, Introduced by Senators SANBORN, PATTERSON and CROPSEY and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, Small Business and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
 "The code of criminal procedure,"  
 by amending section 14g of chapter XVII (MCL 777.14g), as added  
 by 2002 PA 29.
