A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 3111a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3111a. (1) The department shall establish a program to
- 2 encourage monitoring of ambient water quality of the waters of
- 3 the state by citizens and community groups. Participants in this
- 4 program may be referred to as the clean water corps. In

- (a) Provide technical assistance to citizens and community groups who are conducting water quality monitoring.
- (b) Integrate monitoring data from citizens and community groups into water quality assessments and department programs, if

- 1 that data adhere to department quality assurance and quality

- 3 (c) After providing notice and an opportunity for public
- 4 comment, collaboratively develop clear guidelines for water
- 5 quality monitoring procedures and data management practices for

- 7 (d) By June 1, 2003, distribute the guidelines developed
- 8 under subdivision (c) to citizens, community groups, local units
- 9 of government, and other interested persons.
- 10 (e) Improve and expand water quality monitoring activities

- 12 (f) Improve electronic and internet access to water quality
