A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 30111a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 30111a. (1) A person shall not use a dedicated public
- 2 access site except as provided in this section. Unless the
- 3 dedication recorded with the register of deeds specifically
- e provides for other uses, a dedication for public access includes
- only the right of ingress and egress and does not include use of
- the public access for any of the following:
 - (a) Boat hoists.
- 8 (b) Construction of docks unless the purpose of the dock is 9 to aid in the public access and the construction of the dock is .0 authorized by the owner of the riparian land on which the public .1 access site is located.

- 1 (c) Picnicking, sunbathing, or lounging.
- 2 (2) If a dock is located at a dedicated public access site,
- 3 the owner of the riparian land on which the public access site is
- 4 located shall place a sign at the dedicated public access site
- 5 that describes the allowable uses of the public access site and
- 6 describes the activities that are prohibited at the public access
- 7 site.
- 8 (3) A person shall not moor a vessel overnight on bottomland
- 9 directly offshore from a dedicated public access site.
- 10 (4) A person who violates this section is guilty of a
- 11 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 for
- 12 each day of violation. A peace officer may issue an appearance
- 13 ticket as described and authorized by sections 9c to 9g of
- 14 chapter IV of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL
- 15 764.9c to 764.9g, to a person who is in violation of this
- 16 section.
- 17 (5) As used in this section, "dedicated public access" means
- 18 public access to an inland lake or stream dedicated for use by
- 19 the public by a written instrument recorded with the register of
- 20 deeds.
