## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 (a) "Cemetery" means 1 or a combination of more than 1 of the

- 5 (ii) A mausoleum for crypt entombments.

  - (b) "Interment" means the disposition of human remains by
  - earth interment, entombment, or inurnment.
    - (c) "Burial right" means a right of earth interment.
    - (d) "Entombment right" means the right of crypt entombment in

- 1 a mausoleum or in an aboveground vault.
- 2 (e) "Columbarium right" means the right of inurnment in a
- 3 columbarium for cremated remains.
- 4 (f) "Mausoleum" means a structure used, or intended to be

- 6 the remains of deceased persons.
- 7 (g) "Crypt" means a chamber in a mausoleum of sufficient size
- 8 to entomb the uncremated remains of a deceased person.

- 21 public by a cemetery including, but not limited to, caskets,
- 22 vaults, concrete boxes, monuments, memorials, and foundations.
- 23 (m) "Cemetery commissioner" or "commissioner" means the
- 24 director of -licensing and regulation the department of consumer
- 25 and industry services or a designee of the director.
- (n) "Casket" means any box or container consisting of 1 or
- 27 more parts in which a dead human body is placed before interment,

- 1 entombment, or cremation that may or may not be permanently
