HOUSE BILL No. 4456

March 26, 2003, Introduced by Rep. Rocca and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 261, entitled

"An act to authorize the creation and to prescribe the powers and duties of county and regional parks and recreation commissions; and to prescribe the powers and duties of county boards of commissioners with respect to county and regional parks and recreation commissions,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 46.351), as amended by 2000 PA 496.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The county board of commissioners of a county,
- 2 by resolution adopted by a 2/3 vote of all its members, may
- 3 create a county parks and recreation commission, which shall be
- l under the general control of the board of commissioners.
- 5 (2) The county parks and recreation commission shall consist
- 6 of the following 10 members:
- 7 (a) The chairperson of the county road commission or another
- 8 road commissioner designated by the board of county road
- 9 commissioners.

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- 1 (b) The county drain commissioner.
- 2 (c) One of the following:
- 3 (i) In a county that elects a county executive under section
- 4 9 of 1973 PA 139, MCL 45.559, the county executive or a designee
- 5 of the county executive.
- (ii) In a county with a population of 1,000,000 or less, the
- 7 chairperson of the county planning commission or another member
- 8 of the county planning commission designated by the county
- 9 planning commission. In a county that does not have a county
- 10 planning commission, the chairperson of the regional planning
- 11 commission shall serve on the county parks and recreation
- 12 commission if that person is a resident of that county. If the
- 13 chairperson of the regional planning commission is not a resident
- 14 of that county, then the board shall, by a 2/3 vote, appoint a
- 15 member of the regional planning commission who is a resident of
- 16 that county to serve on the county parks and recreation
- 17 commission.
- 18 (d) Seven members appointed by the county board of
- 19 commissioners, not less than 1 and not more than 3 of whom shall
- 20 be members of the board of commissioners. For counties with a
- 21 population greater than 750,000 but less than 1,000,000, at least
- 22 1 of the 7 members appointed shall be an officer of the
- 23 homeowners or property owners association that represents the
- 24 largest area geographically that is located within 1/2 mile from
- 25 the property boundary of the most frequently used county park who
- 26 is willing to serve on the county parks and recreation
- 27 commission. If a homeowners or property owners association is

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- 1 not located within that 1/2-mile area or no officer is willing to
- 2 serve, then at least 1 of the 7 members appointed shall be a
- 3 resident within that 1/2-mile area who is willing to serve on the
- 4 county parks and recreation commission. If no resident lives
- 5 within that 1/2-mile area or no resident is willing to serve,
- 6 then at least 1 of the 7 members appointed shall be a resident of
- 7 the city, village, or township in which the park is located who
- 8 is willing to serve on the county parks and recreation
- 9 commission.
- 10 (3) Of the members first appointed by the county board of
- 11 commissioners, 2 shall be appointed for a term ending 1 year from
- 12 the following January 1, 2 for a term ending 2 years from the
- 13 following January 1, and 3 for a term ending 3 years from the
- 14 following January 1. From then on, each appointed member shall
- 15 be appointed for a term of 3 years and until his or her successor
- 16 is appointed and qualified. Each term shall expire at noon on
- 17 January 1. A vacancy shall be filled by the county board of
- 18 commissioners for the unexpired term.
- 19 (4) The county parks and recreation commission is an agency
- 20 of the county. The county board of commissioners may make rules
- 21 and regulations with respect to the county parks and recreation
- 22 commission as the board of commissioners considers advisable.
- 23 The members of the county parks and recreation commission are not
- 24 full-time officers. -, and the The county board of commissioners
- 25 shall fix the compensation of the members.

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
