

HOUSE BILL No. 4458

March 26, 2003, Introduced by Rep. Rocca and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1958,"
by amending section 122 (MCL 436.1233).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 233. (1) The commission shall establish uniform prices
2 for the sale of alcoholic liquor in state liquor stores and by
3 specially designated distributors. The prices shall return a
4 gross profit to the commission of not less than 51% and not
5 greater than 65%. If alcoholic liquor purchased by the
6 commission has not met sales standards established by the
7 commission for a period of 6 months, the commission may sell the
8 alcoholic liquor at a price to be approved by the state
9 administrative board.

10 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the commission may
11 establish by rule prices for the sale of alcoholic liquor to

1 hospitals, charitable institutions, and military establishments
2 located in this state.

3 (3) There shall be allowed a discount of ~~17%~~ 20% deducted
4 from the sale price established by the commission on the sale of
5 alcoholic liquor made by the state liquor stores to specially
6 designated distributors and establishments licensed to sell for
7 consumption on the premises.
