THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 804. (1) A boxing match or exhibition for prizes or
- 2 purses, or for which an admission fee is charged or received, may
- 3 be held within the state, subject to the direction, management,
- 4 and control of the department.
- 5 (2) This article does not allow the conduct of a tough man
 - contest. As used in this subsection:
- 7 (a) "Tough man contest" means an unarmed combat elimination
- 8 contest between any 2 or more individuals.
- 9 (b) "Unarmed combat" means any form of competition in which a
- 10 blow is usually struck that may reasonably be expected to inflict

- 2 (3) -(2) This article does not apply to boxing matches or
- 3 exhibitions conducted by or participated in exclusively by a
- 4 department or agency of the United States government or by a

- 7 universities if each contestant in the match or exhibition is an
- 8 amateur.
