HOUSE BILL No. 4991

July 17, 2003, Introduced by Reps. Byrum, Jamnick, Tobocman, Accavitti, Bieda and Hardman and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to require public employers to grant public employees a leave of absence to serve as precinct election inspectors without loss of pay or benefits; to impose certain duties on public employees who request a leave of absence to serve as precinct election inspectors; and to impose certain duties on certain public officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "public employee precinct election inspector leave of absence

- Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Person" means an individual, sole proprietorship,
