by amending section 601b (MCL 257.601b), as amended by 2001 PA 103.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 601b. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 2 act, a person responsible for a moving violation in a
- 3 construction zone, at an emergency scene, or in a school zone
- 4 during the period beginning 30 minutes before school in the
- 5 morning and through 30 minutes after school in the afternoon is
- subject to a fine that is double the fine otherwise prescribed

- 10 working in the construction zone is guilty of a misdemeanor
