## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 161a. If an individual is participating in the child
- 2 support amnesty program established under section 3b of the

- 4 prosecution shall not be initiated under section 161, 165,
- 5 167(1)(a), or 167(2) during the amnesty period. If prosecution
- 6 has been initiated before the individual seeks to participate in
  - the child support amnesty program, the individual is not eligible
- 8 to participate in the child support amnesty program. A payer who
- 9 makes full payment of past due support during the amnesty period
- 10 shall not be prosecuted for failing to pay support due before the
