- 1 (1) The owner or operator of a landfill or Sec. 11514a. municipal solid waste incinerator shall inspect each day at least 1 load of the solid waste delivered to the disposal area that day and shall inspect each year at least 1% of the loads of solid HOUSE BILL No. 5284 waste delivered to the disposal area that year.
 - (2) If a load of solid waste is rejected by the owner or operator of a landfill or municipal solid waste incinerator because it contains materials whose disposal at the disposal area is prohibited under this act or rules promulgated under this act, a solid waste hauler shall not subsequently deliver the load to a landfill or municipal solid waste incinerator in this state for
