## **HOUSE BILL No. 5469**

February 5, 2004, Introduced by Reps. Hager, Hoogendyk, Acciavatti, Brandenburg, Stahl, Stewart, Nitz, Spade, Voorhees, Hummel, Kooiman, DeRossett, Taub, Vander Veen and Sheen and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1887 PA 128, entitled

"An act establishing the minimum ages for contracting marriages; to require a civil license in order to marry and its registration; to provide for the implementation of federal law; and to provide a penalty for the violation of this act,"

(MCL 551.101 to 551.111) by amending the title, as amended by 1998 PA 333, and by adding section 12.
