THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 321a. (1) A person who operates a motor vehicle while
- 2 fatigued and, as a result of the operation of that motor vehicle,
- 3 causes the death of another person is guilty of a felony
- 4 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 15 years or a fine
- 5 of not more than \$10,000.00, or both.
 - (2) A person may be prosecuted for, convicted of, and
- sentenced for any other violation of law arising out of the same
- 8 criminal transaction as the violation of this section in lieu of
- 9 being prosecuted for, convicted of, and sentenced for the
- 10 violation of this section.
 - (3) As used in this section, "fatigued" means not having
