A bill to establish the Amanda's fund for breast cancer research in the department of community health; to provide for the distribution of money from the fund; to prescribe the duties and powers of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Amanda's fund for cancer research act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of community health.
 - (b) "Fund" means the Amanda's fund for breast cancer research created in section 3.
- 7 Sec. 3. (1) The Amanda's fund for breast cancer research is
- 8 created in the department to provide funds to promote research in
- 9 this state relating to breast cancer.

- 1 to fund with money from the fund. The department shall solicit
- 2 proposals and approve proposals for funding under this act.
- 3 Proposals may be submitted only by individuals, groups, and
- 4 institutions with an interest in breast cancer research
- 5 activities.
- **6** (2) The department shall review and approve proposals
- 7 submitted for funding under this act and shall give priority to
- 8 proposals submitted by applicants that are located in this state
- 9 and that conduct the research or other activity that is the basis
- 10 for the proposal in this state. The money in the fund shall be
- 11 used to fund, but is not limited to funding, the following types

- 13 (a) Proposals for applied breast cancer research.
