HOUSE BILL No. 6086

July 21, 2004, Introduced by Reps. Ruth Johnson, LaJoy and Voorhees and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to provide for occupational regulatory agencies to allow the use of on-line or other electronic continuing education or continuing competency programs under certain circumstances; to provide for certain powers and duties for certain state regulatory agencies; and to provide for the promulgation of rules.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "on-line continuing education act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "License" means a certificate, registration, or license
- 5 issued by an occupational regulatory agency that allows an
- 6 individual to engage in a regulated occupation or that allows an
- 7 individual to use a specific title in the practice of an
- 8 occupation, profession, or vocation.

- 1 (b) "Occupational regulatory agency" means a department,
- 2 bureau, or agency of this state that has regulatory authority
- 3 over a regulated occupation.
- 4 (c) "Regulated occupation" means an occupation, profession,
- 5 or vocation that requires a license as a predicate for the
- 6 practice of the occupation, profession, or vocation or that
- 7 provides for the use of a specific title in the practice of the
- 8 occupation, profession, or vocation.
- 9 Sec. 3. (1) Except as otherwise provided for in a specific
- 10 act concerning a regulated occupation, the occupational
- 11 regulatory agency requiring a program of continuing education or
- 12 continuing professional competency for renewal of a license shall
- 13 allow at least 1/2 of the required credit hours of continuing
- 14 education or continuing professional competency be earned through
- 15 an on-line or electronic media meeting standards acceptable to
- 16 the occupational regulatory agency.
- 17 (2) An occupational regulatory agency may promulgate rules
- 18 under the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL
