## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 473. (1) Except as otherwise provided in
- 2 subsection (4), a A person shall not use a tobacco product on
- 3 school property.
- 4 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 5 misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00.
- 6 (3) As used in this section:
- (a) "School district" means a school district, local act
- 8 school district, or intermediate school district, as those terms
