## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 CHAPTER II

2 Sec. 10c. (1) A violation of the identity theft protection

act, or a violation of law committed in furtherance of or arising

from the same transaction as a violation of the identity theft

protection act, may be prosecuted in 1 of the following

jurisdictions:

- (a) The jurisdiction in which the offense occurred.
- (b) The jurisdiction in which the information used to commit **9** 10 the violation was illegally used.
  - (c) The jurisdiction in which the victim resides.
  - (2) If a person is charged with more than 1 violation of the
