HOUSE BILL No. 6205

September 9, 2004, Introduced by Reps. LaJoy, Ward, Shaffer, Tobocman, Meyer, Taub, Moolenaar, Stakoe and Pastor and referred to the Committee on Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 197, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of a downtown development authority; to prescribe its powers and duties; to correct and prevent deterioration in business districts; to encourage historic preservation; to authorize the acquisition and disposal of interests in real and personal property; to authorize the creation and implementation of development plans in the districts; to promote the economic growth of the districts; to create a board; to prescribe its powers and duties; to authorize the levy and collection of taxes; to authorize the issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness; to authorize the use of tax increment financing; to reimburse downtown development authorities for certain losses of tax increment revenues; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officials,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 125.1657), as amended by 2004 PA 196.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 7. The board may:
- (a) Prepare an analysis of economic changes taking place in

- 17 (k) Lease any building or property under its control, or any
- 18 part of a building or property.
- 19 (1) Accept grants and donations of property, labor, or other
- 20 things of value from a public or private source.
- 21 (m) Acquire and construct public facilities.
- (n) Create, operate, and fund marketing initiatives that
- 23 benefit only retail and general marketing of the downtown
- 24 district.
- 25 (o) Contract for broadband service and wireless technology
- 26 service in the downtown district.
- 27 (p) Evaluate, develop, and implement programs designed to

- 1 inform and attract potential customers and tenants to the
- 2 downtown district and to retain existing customers and tenants,
- 3 which programs in the opinion of the board are expected to aid in
- 4 the economic vitality and growth of the downtown district.
