

# HOUSE BILL No. 6238

September 29, 2004, Introduced by Rep. Bradstreet and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1962 PA 192, entitled  
"Professional service corporation act,"  
by amending section 4 (MCL 450.224), as amended by 2000 PA 335.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 4. (1) One or more licensed persons may organize under  
2 this act to become a shareholder or shareholders of a  
3 professional corporation for pecuniary profit.

4       (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3) or  
5 otherwise prohibited, a professional corporation may ~~render~~  
6 **provide** 1 or more professional services, except that each  
7 shareholder must be a licensed person in 1 or more of the  
8 professional services ~~rendered~~ **provided** by the corporation.

9       ~~(3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, if the~~  
10 **If a** professional corporation ~~renders a~~ **provides 1 or more**  
11 professional ~~service that is~~ **services that are** included within

1 the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211,  
2 then ~~all shareholders~~ **each shareholder** of the corporation  
3 ~~shall~~ **must** be licensed or legally authorized ~~in this state to~~  
4 ~~render the same professional service. One or more physicians and~~  
5 ~~surgeons licensed~~ under the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL  
6 333.1101 to 333.25211, ~~may organize a professional corporation~~  
7 ~~under this act with 1 or more physicians and surgeons licensed~~  
8 ~~under different provisions of the public health code, 1978 PA~~  
9 ~~368, MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211~~ **to render a professional service**  
10 **provided by the corporation.**

11 (4) A licensed person of another jurisdiction may become an  
12 officer, director, shareholder, employee, or agent of the  
13 corporation but shall not render any professional service in this  
14 state until the person is licensed or otherwise legally  
15 authorized to render the professional service in this state.
