

SENATE BILL No. 277

March 6, 2003, Introduced by Senator JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of state police and certain other state purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the various state agencies.
