A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 658 (MCL 257.658), as amended by 2002 PA 494.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 658. (1) A person propelling a bicycle or operating a
 motorcycle or moped shall not ride other than upon and astride a
 permanent and regular seat attached to that vehicle.
 - (2) A bicycle or motorcycle shall not be used to carry more persons at 1 time than the number for which it is designed and equipped.
 - (3) A moped or an electric personal assistive mobility device shall not be used to carry more than 1 person at a time.
 - (4) A person operating or riding on a motorcycle, and any person less than 19 years of age operating a moped on a public

- 1 thoroughfare shall wear a crash helmet on his or her head. Crash
- 2 helmets shall be approved by the department of state police. The
