SENATE BILL No. 431

May 1, 2003, Introduced by Senators BRATER, SCOTT, JACOBS, BERNERO and LELAND and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 152, entitled "State license fee act,"

by amending sections 3, 37, and 38 (MCL 338.2203, 338.2237, and 338.2238), section 3 as amended by 1993 PA 139, section 37 as amended by 2002 PA 633, and section 38 as amended by 1999 PA 171; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The fees prescribed by this act shall be used
- 2 only to offset the cost of operating the department.
- 3 (2) Except as otherwise provided in sections 37, 38, and 51,
- 4 the fees collected pursuant to this act shall be credited to the
- 5 general fund of the state.
- 6 (3) The license and registration fees set forth in sections
- ' 11, 13, 15, 17, 21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31, 37, 38, 39, 43, 49, and

- 24 and each succeeding fiscal year shall be deposited into the real

- 6 <u>(d) Temporary permit fee......\$125.00</u>
- 7 (2) The license fee includes a fee imposed by the federal
- 8 government under sections 1113 and 1114 of title XI of the
- 9 financial institutions reform, recovery, and enforcement act of
- 10 1989, Public Law 101-73, 12 U.S.C. 3331 to 3351, for certified
- 11 general real estate appraisers, certified residential real estate
- 12 appraisers, and state licensed real estate appraisers, which
- 13 shall not exceed \$50.00 per licensee and which the department
- 14 shall collect and pay to the federal government pursuant to
- 15 section 2637 of the occupational code, MCL 339.2637.
- 17 in the state treasury and shall be administered by the
- 18 department. Ten dollars of each fee received -under subsection
