## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4bb. (1) A person subject to the tax under this act may exclude from the gross proceeds used for the computation of the tax the sale of the following products if that product has been awarded the energy star certification mark:
- 5 (a) Clothes washers.
  - (b) Refrigerators.
    - (c) Room air conditioners.
    - (d) Lighting fixtures.
    - (e) Compact fluorescent lightbulbs.
- 10 (f) Ceiling fans.
  - (g) Torchiere lamps.
