- 22 (b) The number of convictions entered.
- 23 (c) The number of acquittals entered.
- 24 (d) The average length of imprisonment imposed.
- 25 (e) The average length of community service imposed in lieu
- 26 of imprisonment.
- 27 (f) The average fine imposed.
