THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 33a. (1) Beginning the effective date of the
- 2 amendatory act that added this section and notwithstanding the
- 3 license and permit fees imposed under sections 31 and 33, the
- 4 department shall issue an initial or renewal license or permit
- 5 for regulated activities described in sections 31 and 33 not
- 6 later than 6 months after the applicant files a completed
- 7 application. If the application is considered incomplete by the
- 8 department, the department shall notify the applicant in writing
- 9 within 10 days after receipt of the incomplete application,
- 10 describing the deficiency and requesting the additional
- 11 information. The 6-month period is tolled upon notification by

- 2 information is received by the department.
- 3 (2) If the department fails to issue or deny a license or
- 4 permit within the time required by this section, the department
- 5 shall return the license or permit fee and shall reduce the

- 7 application, if any, by 15%. The department shall not
- 8 discriminate against an applicant in the processing of the
- 9 application based upon the fact that the application fee was

- 11 (3) Beginning January 31, 2005, the director shall submit a
- 12 report by January 31 of each year to the standing committees and
